What is Pathways Awarua?

Pathways Awarua is a free, fun and easy way to improve your numeracy and literacy skills online, within a real life context, such as learning to navigate everyday financial decisions.

The **My Money** pathway has been created in consultation with the Commission for Financial Capability to help adults and young adults develop their confidence and competence in money management, while at the same time strengthening their literacy and numeracy capabilities.

Anywhere, anytime, any device.

Pathways Awarua is available on your computer, tablet, or smartphone.

Download apps on the **App Store** and **Google Play**. Once you log in, they work with or without an internet connection, giving you more opportunities for learning - anywhere, anytime.

Other pathways are available to help you improve your essential skills in reading, writing, listening and maths.









How do the modules work?

Module content covers what constitutes a 'good' deal, how to save money, planning for the future, and the real cost of debt and how to reduce it. There are 25 modules available.

The modules are engaging and interactive. You can read the questions yourself, or the audio can read them to you. If you get an answer wrong, you get feedback straightaway, and you can try as many times as you need to. Your progress is tracked so you know where you are at.

How do you register?

You can enter Pathways Awarua through www.GoPlacesNow.co.nz or the short way gpn.nz Click on the registration button. Choose a username and password.

If you have a 'join code' from your educator/employer enter it, otherwise choose the 'no join code' option. Once registered, select a pathway and start learning.
