## What is Pathways Awarua?

Pathways Awarua is a free, fun and easy way to improve numeracy and literacy skills online, within a real life context, such as learning to navigate everyday financial decisions.

The **My Money** pathway has been created in consultation with the Commission for Financial Capability to help adults and young adults develop their confidence and competence in money management, while at the same time strengthening their literacy and numeracy capabilities.

## Anywhere, anytime, any device.

Pathways Awarua is available on computer, tablet, or smartphone.

Download apps on the **App Store** and **Google Play**. Once logged in, they work with or without an internet connection, giving more opportunities for learning – anywhere, anytime!

Other pathways are available to help improve essential skills in reading, writing, listening, vocabulary and maths. There are also applied pathways that help learners with driver licences and health and safety.



## How do the modules work?

Module content covers what constitutes a 'good' deal, how to save money, planning for the future, and the real cost of debt and how to reduce it. There are 25 modules available.

The modules are engaging and interactive. You can read the questions, or the audio can read them to you. If you get an answer wrong, you get feedback straightaway, and you can try as many times as you need to. Progress is tracked, and certificates can be earned along the way.
